1. EANGCH OONLRTC TYESMS      c h a n g e c o n t r o l s y s t e m  
A collection of formal documented procedures that define how project deliverables and documentation will be controlled, changed, and approved.
2. CSARTSNOTNI      c o n s t r a i n t s  
Is an applicable restriction that will affect the performance of the project.
3. RKWO TUIRIZHAOTAON MSSETY      w o r k a u t h o r i z a t i o n s y s t e m  
Is a formal procedure for sanctioning project work to ensure that work is done at the right time and in the proper sequence.
4. TACTOCNR      c o n t r a c t  
A document from the customer's acquiring organization is an input if the project is being done for an external customer.
5. PETRXE GNMUDTJE      e x p e r t j u d g m e n t  
A type of judgment provided based upon expertise in an application area.
6. ORTPCJE CSEPO TNESMTTEA      p r o j e c t s c o p e s t a t e m e n t  
The narrative description of the project scope, that provides a documented basis for making future project decisions.
7. EERICTOCRVSIAOCNT      c o r r e c t i v e a c t i o n s  
Documented, authorized directions required to bring expected future project performance into conformance with the project management plan.
8. PJCREOT ETNEMGMNAA LNPA      p r o j e c t m a n a g e m e n t p l a n  
A formal, approved document that defines how the project is executed, monitored and controlled.
9. OCPRJETAHERRC      p r o j e c t c h a r t e r  
A document issued by the project sponsor that formally authorizes the existence of a project.
10. TPNSISAUMOS      a s s u m p t i o n s  
Factors that, for planning purposes, are considered to be true, real, or certain.
11. TETETMANSFOKRWO      s t a t e m e n t o f w o r k  
is a narrative description of products or services to be supplied by the project.
12. CEDTEFPERARI      d e f e c t r e p a i r  
Is the documented, authorized request for product correction of a defect found during the quality inspection or the audit process.
13. SLNSESONEALEDR      L e s s o n s l e a r n e d  
The causes of variances, the reasoning behind the corrective action chosen for example.
14. CANGEHERUTEQSS      c h a n g e r e q u e s t s  
are the documented, authorized changes to expand or contract project scope. The approved change requests can also modify policies, project management plans, procedures, costs or budgets, or revise schedules.
15. PMSI      P M I S  
is a standardized set of automated tools available within the organization and integrated into a system.
16. FNBIETEMREESANEMTUDHEMOST      b e n e f i t m e a s u r e m e n t m e t h o d s  
Are comparative approaches, scoring models, benefit contribution, or economic models.
17. RETCJPOSNEEOTCIL ETDHMOS      p r o j e c t s e l e c t i o n m e t h o d s  
Are used to determine which project the organization will select.
18. ALCSRTHIOIFAIRONOINTM      h i s t o r i c a l i n f o r m a t i o n  
e.g., estimating databases, records of past project performance
19. NEIVVPERETICONTSA      p r e v e n t i v e a c t i o n s  
Preventive actions are documented, authorized directions that reduce the probability of negative consequences associated with project risks.
